ONE OF THE LAST country houses to be built under PPG7 guidelines has just been granted planning permission. Paul+O Architects will shortly begin work on the Wilderness House in Suffolk, which could be one of the last isolated, substantial houses to be built on a greenfield site for some time. The PPG7 guidelines allowed for such houses in the countryside if they were 'outstanding in terms of architecture and landscape design'. A Draft Planning Policy Statement 7 (PPS7), currently out for consultation, will replace PPG7, omitting this clause.
